
This assignment includes two parts, your post and at least one reply. You must make your own post first to then see the rest of your classmates and reply. Lastly, I give you an example post to follow.

- Share three potential upcoming changes to the determinants of demand and supply for the final good/service and explain how you think they will affect your desired job market.
 - Hurricanes: because Lifeguards work at a beach, anything that prevents humans from enjoying the beach will also prevent the need for a Lifeguard. Hurricanes can cause beaches to become unsafe for visitors during the storm and for weeks after depending on the damage to the beach and its surrounding town's infrastructure. Visitors still will not come to beach if there are no hotels to stay in or restaurants to eat at. A hurricane can cause a decrease in supply by being closed down, or a decrease in demand through the decrease in consumer taste when they decide they no longer want to visit a beach without open hotels or restaurants.
 - Pandemics: because pandemics can cause additional restrictions for humans being in contact with each other, beaches close down like they did during COVID-19. If beaches close down, it has a similar affect of hurricanes and will decrease demand for Lifeguards.
 - Beach Themed Entertainment: an increase in beach themed entertainment such as Baywatch or the new Barbie movie, should increase the consumer tastes of beaches which will increase beach demand. With more visitors to the beach, we should see an increase in demand for Lifeguards.





 - 2. Equilibrium price is \$42, so we add up the triangles and square above it: 137 + 126 + 273 = \$536 total consumer surplus.




- Our findings reveal that around 80% of the U.S. workforce could have at least 10% of their work tasks affected by the introduction of LLMs, while approximately 19% of workers may see at least 50% of their tasks impacted.
- The projected effects span all wage levels, with higher-income jobs potentially facing greater exposure to LLM capabilities and LLMpowered software.
- Our analysis suggests that, with access to an LLM, about 15% of all worker tasks in the US could be completed significantly faster at the same level of quality.
- When incorporating software and tooling built on top of LLMs, this share increases to between 47 and 56% of all tasks.

Klarna

New York, NY – February 27, 2024 – <u>Klarna</u> today announced its AI assistant powered by OpenAI. Now live globally for 1 month, the numbers speak for themselves:

- The Al assistant has had 2.3 million conversations, two-thirds of Klarna's customer service chats
- It is doing the equivalent work of 700 full-time agents
- It is on par with human agents in regard to customer satisfaction score
- It is more accurate in errand resolution, leading to a 25% drop in repeat inquiries
- Customers now resolve their errands in less than 2 mins compared to 11 mins previously






